

¿Qué es AHNA?

Map of the Asylum Hill Neighborhood

Asylum Hill is defined as:
Westerly by the north branch of the Park River.
Northerly by the railroad tracks south of Hinckley Avenue and Walnut Street.
Easterly by the railroad tracks running to the west of Union Place.
Southerly by railroad tracks from the corner of Hinckley and Walnut Street, to the south of 555 Asylum Avenue, up to the intersection of the railroad tracks and the Park River.
