Appointments for pickup will be available at the following locations:

- Thursdays, Barbour Library, 261 Barbour Street

Contact-free pickup is already offered at the Downtown Library, Campfield Library, and the Albany Library. Contact-free pickup can also be arranged through our Library on Wheels.

Customers can place a hold on library materials online or over the phone. They can then make an appointment to safely pick up their materials.
