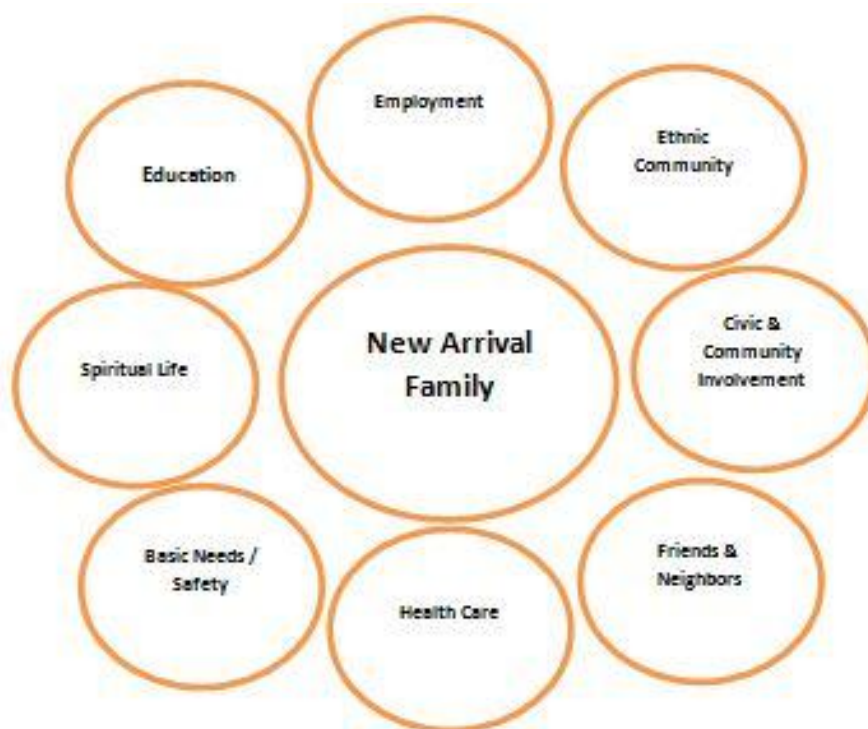

Cost:

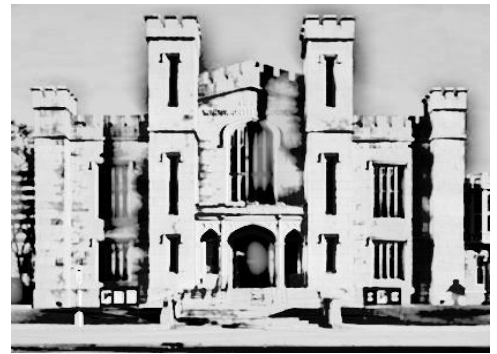
The Hartford Public Library offers free museum passes at the Circulation Desk, main floor.

Task 5

Ask one question related to your child's needs.
