
Hartford Public Library and Hartford Stage Partnership Offers Free Tickets for Library Cardholders, Ambassadors

January 5, 2018 — Hartford Public Library and Hartford Stage have a partnership that makes free theater tickets available to Library cardholders, allows Neighborhood Ambassadors from Hartford neighborhoods to see live theater and bring others with them to shows, and creates a mini-library at the theater of show-related books that can be checked out with an HPL library card. Theater tickets. Each of the seven branches of Hartford Public Library will have a two-ticket pass per eligible show. Patrons can check on line to see where passes are available, but they must ask for them in person at any of

the seven HPL locations. Patrons must confirm the seats by calling Hartford Stage at 860-527-5151.

After seeing preview performances, Ambassadors can return with up to three other guests, Hartford residents ages 18 and older, and see the play again at no charge. The goal is to invite new people from the community to join the Ambassador Program throughout the season. (Hartford Stage will select the performances for the return visits.)

Ambassadors and their guests will complete post show surveys about their playgoing experience and give feedback on how the program could be improved.
