

## Hartford Public Library Releases Free Hartford Stage Tickets; City Residents and HPL Cardholders Eligible To Claim Seats

**January 31, 2018** — Seats to the Hartford Stage presentation of "Agatha Christie's Murder on the Orient Express" will be available Monday, February 5, to Hartford residents who are HPL cardholders in a new partnership.

The arrangement began with Sharon Washington's show, "Feeding the Dragon," about her childhood spent in a custodial apartment in the New York Public Library.



"Murder on the Orient Express" runs
February 15 through March 18. Cardholding city residents are eligible to
reserve two tickets during the run. Patrons
can check on line for ticket availability
starting February 5, but must ask for
tickets in person at any of the seven
Library locations. Once claimed, seats
must be confirmed by calling the Hartford
Stage at 860-527-5151. (Allow an hour
after claiming for processing.)

The program will continue for the

productions of "The Age of Innocence" and "Statements After an Arrest Under the Immorality Act." Tickets for those productions will be available closer to the run of the shows.
