[Hartford, CT] Hartford Public Library (HPL) is proud to announce that it has received the inaugural CT State Library 2025 Excellence in Public Libraries award for its innovative programming. HPL was one of six libraries selected from across the state.

In its first year, the CT State Library received 35 submissions covering all award categories. A diverse panel of reviewers, representing academic and public library professionals, partner state agencies, educators, community leaders, and representatives from the State Library, evaluated the nominations and selected the award recipients. The criteria considered included library achievements, community impact, innovation, leadership, collaboration, and sustainability.
