USING THE BUS IN HARTFORD

Main Street Bus Stops in downtown Hartford:

Many buses stop at **Capital Community College** (950 Main Street). It is the first stop after the stop at Old State House.

The **Old State House Post Office** is located in the square between Main and Market Street. The entrance of the Post Office is across from the **CT**TRANSIT sales building.

Many buses stop close to the **Hartford Public Library.** From Main Street, walk down Arch Street to the entrance of the library. (The library is across from the Hartford City Hall.) See map.

To get to the **International Institute of Connecticut** (330 Main Street), get off the bus on Main Street and walk down Charter Oak Avenue to the entrance of the building. See map.

IS THIS MY BUS?

You can tell where a bus is going when it pulls up to the stop. Look at the sign above the windshield to see the route letter/number, the name of the route and the last stop of the bus. If you need help, ask the bus driver and he or she will be able to tell you what bus you need to take to your final stop.





To get from Main Street in downtown Hartford to the Camp Field Branch of The Hartford Public Library (30 Campfield Avenue):

Stand on Main Street at the corner of Main and Gold Streets in front of the Center Church. Wait for the "N-1 Campfield Ave" bus. Ride to the first stop on Campfield Avenue and exit the bus across from Saint Augustus Church. The library is across the road. To return to Main Street, stand in front of Saint Augustus Church and pick up any N-Windsor bus (numbered 2 through 7). The one-way trip should take about 10 minutes.



To get from Main Street in downtown Hartford to the Dwight Parkville Branch of The Hartford Public Library (7 New Park Avenue):

Stand at the corner of Main and Pearl Streets in front of the Gold Building and get on the K-3, K-4 or K-5 bus. Ride to the corner of Park and New Park Streets. The library is across Park Street from the bank. To return to Main Street, stand outside the library and pick up any K bus returning to Main Street. The one-way trip should take about 15 minutes.



To get from Main Street in downtown Hartford to the Hartford Adult Education building (245 Locust Street):

Walk down Central Row to the bus shelters and get on the G-Locust Street (G-1) bus to 245 Locust Street. To return to Main Street, pick up the G-Downtown bus by crossing Locust Street and waiting at the bus stop sign. The one-way trip should take about 15 minutes.



To get from Main Street in downtown Hartford to the Weston Street Post Office:

At the Old State House stop, wait for the W-3 bus to the Weston Street Post

Office. To return to Main Street, pick up the W, W-1 or W-2 bus in front of the Post Office. The one-way trip should take about 15 minutes.



To get from Main Street in downtown Hartford to Greater Hartford Legal Aid (999 Asylum Avenue):

Stand in front of St. Paul Travelers (750 Main Street)

and pick up either the "A-1 or A-2 Asylum Avenue" bus or the "S Granby Street" bus. Get off the bus at the corner of Asylum Avenue and Atwood Street. You will see 999 Asylum Avenue when you get off the bus. The one-way trip should take about 20-25 minutes.



To get from 125 Market Street, Catholic Charities, to the downtown Branch of the Hartford Public Library:

Walk south on Market Street toward Central Row. Market Street turns into Prospect Street, keep walking until Arch Street. Turn up Arch Street to The Hartford Public Library.

RIDING THE BUS

- Get to the bus stop at least five minutes before the bus is supposed to stop there.
- Have your bus fare, pass or ticket ready before you get on the bus.
- If you need another bus to complete this trip, ask the driver for a transfer ticket when you get on the bus and pay your fare. On the next bus, just insert the ticket into the farebox.
- Do not cross the street in front of the bus, it is not safe. Wait until the bus has pulled away before you cross the street.

BUS STOPS

There are bus stops every 2-3 blocks on the bus route. Many stops are marked with a bus stop sign. Some stops have a white band painted on a pole.

GETTING OFF THE BUS

About one block from your stop, pull the cord above the side windows to let the bus driver know that you need to stop. A noise will sound and a sign will light up at the front of the bus to tell the driver to stop.

PAYING YOUR FARE

You can pay the fare with cash, ticket or pass. If you choose to pay your fare in cash, be sure to have exact fare because fareboxes cannot give change. The farebox takes only \$1.00 bills and all U.S. coins.

If you plan to ride the bus often, you may buy one of many passes to save money. Ask for more information at the **CT**TRANSIT Customer Service and Sales Outlet in State House Square in downtown Hartford.
