

### **Distance Learning Coordinator**

The Distance Learning Coordinator will coordinate and collaborate with educational staff to develop engaging and effective distance learning courses, and will evaluate, select and implement instructional technology materials and software that supports course learning goals and objectives. Responsibilities include:

#### Development

- Coordinate and collaborate with educational staff to develop engaging and effective distance learning courses and content that meet program goals and objectives
- Create and maintain websites and platforms that support virtual learning programs
- Collaborate with educational staff in the evaluation, selection and implementation of instructional technology materials and software that supports course learning goals and objectives
- Collaborate with students to develop optimal learner centered conditions

#### Training

- Train administrators and teaching staff in the use or support of virtual learning applications and best practices
- Create and revise online course instructional guides to support student training and engagement

#### Reporting

- Support the delivery and evaluation of online trainings, modules and lessons focusing on continuous improvement in distance learning
- Compile and analyze feedback from past, present and prospective students and instructors to ensure a high-quality of online learning
- Submit weekly and monthly reports including student attendance, challenges and successes, and progress/gains
