Naturalization Ceremony To Be Held Election Day At Library

November 6, 2017 — Meet our newest American citizens on Tuesday, Nov. 7, at a reception following an 11 a.m. Naturalization Ceremony in the Atrium, on the ground floor of the Hartford Public Library, 500 Main St.

Speakers include Bridget Quinn-Carey, CEO of the Library; Lt.Gov. Nancy Wyman; and Sect. of State Denise Merrill. The Pledge of Allegiance will be led by a George Washington impersonator. Jose Paulo will sing the National Anthem, and the state Dept. of Corrections Honor Guard Pipe & Drum Band will lead Presentation of the Colors.

Ethan Enzer, section chief of the U.S. Citizen and Immigration services, is the master of ceremonies. The Hon. Donna F. Martinez, U.S. Magistrate Jude for the District of Connecticut, will preside after Robert Wood, deputy clerk of court, opens a special session of the U.S. District Court.
